Mrs Stevens, teacher of Physics at KES and examiner for both GCSE and A Level Physics will run a series of mini-teach sessions with supported past paper question practice on those topics which are common across GCSE exam boards such as Energy Transfers, Electricity and Magnets, Waves and Radioactivity, with a final session on exam technique and 6-mark questions.

Pure Maths (Edexcel)

Each session will focus on a key topic taken from the A Level Syllabus. These include Differentiation, Integration, Trigonometry, Numerical Methods, Sequences and Series and Binomial Expansion. There will be time for pupils to be supported through exam paper practise along with tips on exam technique.

Chemistry (Edexcel/OCR)

Ms Miners, teacher of Chemistry at KES, will run a series of mini-teach sessions with past paper practise and feedback on structuring an exam response on key A Level topic areas including Acid base Equilibria, Redox Chemistry, Organic Chemistry and Spectroscopy.
