



KES TRANSPORT SERVICES 2024-25

King Edward's School operates seven services to ensure pupils can attend the School both locally and from further afield. All services operate at the start and end of the day, other than the Lansdown Park & Ride service, which is morning only.

New routes/stops for 2024/2025 are highlighted in Bold

- 1. Midsomer Norton Radstock Peasedown Saint John Wellow*
- 2. Frome Beckington Hinton Charterhouse Combe Down*
- 3. Chippenham Corsham Box Batheaston London Road*
- 4. Westbury Trowbridge Bradford-on-Avon*
- 5. Bath Service: Odd Down Bear Flat Manvers Street (Bath Spa Train station) *
- 6. Lansdown Park & Ride (Morning only service)
- 7. KES Pre-Prep (Weston) KES North Road*

Below are details of the routes and prices. If you would like to book your child on any of these routes, or if you have any questions on these transport services, please email Natasha Dulieu at <u>n.dulieu@kesbath.com</u> Please note that when booking a bus service priority is given to pupils already on the bus, after this spaces are issued out on a first come, first served, basis with a waiting list being formed when necessary.

*These services are run on behalf of the School by Beeline Coaches.

TRANSPORT SERVICE COSTS PER TERM:

The Midsomer Norton, Frome, Chippenham and Westbury routes are all charged at **£470 per term.** For pupils catching the Chippenham bus from Batheaston onwards, the charge is **£280 per term.**

The Bath Service (Combe Down, Odd Down & Bear Flat) is charged at **£290 per term.** For pupils catching this service from Bath Spa Train Station, the costs are detailed below.

For those of you who have more than one child using the School transport services, a discount is applied.

- First child Nil
- Second child 25%
- Third child 75%
- Subsequent children 25%



Pupils in Year 11 and Year 13 will be offered a 25% discount during the Summer Term to take into account study leave and exams.

All routes are available to use on a full-time basis. When space permits, part-time travel is also available at two thirds of the termly cost. Priority is always given to those who are wanting to use the transport service on a full-time basis.

If space permits on the above services, one day travel is provided at £12 a day, with notice given **at least 24 hours** before travel.

LANSDOWN PARK & RIDE TO KES SERVICE (MORNINGS ONLY)

The School also provides a service from the Lansdown Park & Ride and from the bus stop on Lansdown Road, just down from the Kingswood School pedestrian crossing. Due to the historic demand for this service, from September 2024 we will be running two buses.

This service runs in the morning only and cannot be booked on an ad-hoc basis.

The charge is **£100 a term**

Pick-up points and times:

- Lansdown Park & Ride: Departs 07.20 & 8.00am
- Lansdown Road: Departs 07.30 & 8.10am
- Arrive at KES, North Road 07.40 & 8.25am

All pupils are asked to be at the bus stop **5 minutes before the minibus is due to arrive**.

CONNECTING SERVICE BETWEEN THE PRE-PREP AND NORTH ROAD SITES

A daily connecting coach and morning only minibus service operate between KES Pre-Prep and KES Junior / Senior School at North Road.

There is a charge of **£100 Per Term** for parents who use the service to drop their children off at either one of the KES sites. The charge is reduced to **£50 per term** if you are booked onto the AM service only.

Parents who have children at both the North Road site and the Pre-Prep site, can use the service for **free**.

- The coach leaves the Pre-Prep* for the North Road site** at 8.00am.
- There are two minibus departures leaving the Pre-Prep for the North Road site at 7.45am and 8.15am
- The coach departing from the North Road site** for the Pre-Prep leaves at 8.30am.
- The evening coach from the Pre-Prep to the North Road site** leaves at 3.30pm.
- The evening coach from the North Road site^{**} to the Pre-Prep leaves at 4.15pm.

*Pre-Prep Pick-up – Coaches and minibus collect via the bus stop located on Weston Road opposite the junction of Cranhill Road (Near to the top corner of Royal Victoria Park) **North Road site - Coaches collect and drop off via the Lower Entrance, outside of the Senior School Sports Hall



BUS SERVICE FROM BATH SPA TRAIN STATION TO KES

For those pupils who come into Bath by train, Pupils should get on to the Bath **Service, timings** listed above, which transports pupils to and from the train station.

This service costs **£154 per term.**

You can also purchase one way termly tickets for **£90.00 per term**.

We are no longer selling books of tickets. For those with unused tickets, these will still be valid until January 2025. Priority will be given to those pupils who are booked onto the bus on a full-time basis.


